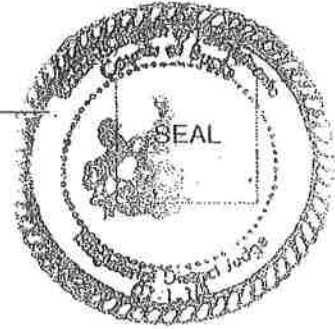

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your affiants are Detective David Hanks and Detective Michael Walp of the Bucks County Detectives and Detective Michael Slaughter of the Bristol Township Police Department.

On July 8, 2014 a home invasion robbery and double murder (hereinafter Bristol Township murders) occurred in the Winder Village Section of Bristol Township, Bucks County. Bristol Township police responded at approximately 12:37 AM and found a male suffering from a gunshot wound outside 911 Winder Drive and two additional victims of gunshot wounds inside 913 Winder Drive. The two victims, Joshua Johnson (DOB: 10/1/84) and Tyrone Moss (DOB: 7/14/82), died of their gunshot wounds. Moss was dead at the scene but Johnson died later at the hospital. The victim, Lamel Duffy (DOB: 2/22/90), was found outside of 911 Winder Drive. Duffy survived his wounds. At the time of this robbery/murder Johnson lived alone at 913 Winder Drive. Johnson was confined to a wheelchair.

Police subsequently interviewed Duffy and he stated that he, Moss and Johnson were in the house playing video games in the living room. He stated that three males wearing black clothing, bags on their feet and faces covered came into the house. When the males entered the house, they pulled Johnson out of his wheelchair and threw him onto the floor. As this was occurring, one of them stated "What we got?". Duffy stated that the males used zip ties to tie his hands behind his back. Duffy was pistol whipped in the head. Duffy was forced to the floor. He stated that after one of the males had left the room that male came back and said "it is flat line time" and they began to shoot the victims. Duffy was able to break the zip ties, exit the residence and yell for help. A neighbor called 911 on July 8, 2014 at 12:37 AM. Duffy reported that his ring and watch were stolen off his hand and some cash was taken from him.

On January 13, 2016 Detectives Hanks and Mosiniak interviewed Demetrius Baker. at the Warwick Township Police HQ. During this interview Baker admitted that he Anthony King whom he knew as "K" and a third subject, who he had only met for the first time that night, travelled from West Philadelphia to Bristol Township late in the night on July 7th 2014. Their intent was to commit a robbery and theft. Baker knew that the third subject was armed with a firearm. Baker's role in the robbery had been determined prior to entering the home.

Baker told detectives that he, Baker, entered the home with King and the third subject. The third subject was armed with a handgun and had his face covered. Baker said that there were three male victims inside the home. Two of the males were ordered to the ground and the third male, (Johnson) who was in a wheelchair, was pulled from his wheelchair by King. As King removed Johnson a small handgun fell from Johnson. King took this gun. Baker told Detectives that he found marijuana and US Currency in the bedroom of the house and took it. Baker said that they also took a video console, clothes, sneakers, a piggy bank and a revolver handgun during the robbery and that the third subject took a wrist watch from one of the victims. Baker said that he, Baker, left the home with the marijuana and cash and went to his car that was parked in front of the home. While in his car Baker heard gunshots and that King and the third subject then returned to his car and Baker drove them back to Philadelphia.

Wherefor your affiant request a warrant be issued for the arrest of Demetrius Baker for the charges of Homicide, Robbery, Burglary, Criminal Conspiracy, Theft and Aggravated Assault.

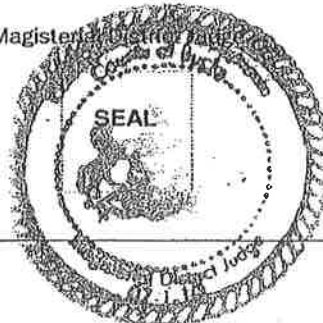
