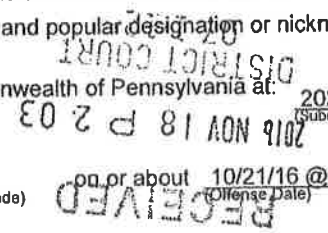

## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On 10/21/16, at approximately 1530hrs, while working an assigned 15-2300hrs shift for the Pennsylvania State Police, Bureau of Gaming Enforcement, Parx/Bensalem gaming office, I was advised by Parx surveillance of the discovery of a threatening letter found on a table on the first floor of Parx East which is located at 3001 Street Road, Bensalem Twp., Bucks County.

At approximately 1545hrs I arrived on scene and met with guest service employees. One of the employees directed me to the location of the letter. The letter was a piece of paper towel with "death to all niggers" hand written on it. The employee related to me that she had discovered the letter on a high table near the former noodle bar of the premises located on the first floor. She related that she and other employees were prepping that exact area for an annual banquet which would be hosting members of the Bucks County NAACP later that afternoon. I observed signage for this event around the immediate area at this time. The note was taken, photographed, and later placed into evidence under property record U26-2773.

At approximately 1700hrs, I met with surveillance officials and reviewed the footage of the incident. They back tracked the actor's movements and found that he had arrived at Parx East on 10/21/16 at approximately 1215hrs. It appears that he spent his entire duration on the first floor of Parx East in the horse betting area. At 1432hrs he is observed leaving the men's restroom nearest the noodle bar. He then approached a high top table in the vicinity and left the note. He then immediately left the premises and is seen entering a silver Buick with a black rag top, unknown registration. His vehicle is observed leaving property via Street Road at approximately 1440hrs. Still image photos of the then unknown actor was obtained and shared with casino and racetrack security.

## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On 10/22/16, at approximately 1500hrs, race track security advised casino surveillance that they believed that they located the actor from this incident. Surveillance officials canvassed the parking lot and found a silver Buick with a black rag top in the same location of the parking lot that the actor parked in the day prior. PA registration JWR6960 which is registered to JEANETTE.

On 10/22/16, at approximately 1530hrs, I arrived at Parx East and met with a security manager. He directed me to JEANETTE's location. Surveillance officials advised me that the person I was observing was the same person who arrived on property in the silver Buick. I compared his likeness to that of the photo of the actor and felt that they were one in the same. Security then approached JEANETTE and asked him to speak with us off to the side of the first floor of the race book.

JEANETTE was identified at this time via his PA driver's license. During our conversation, JEANETTE confirmed that he was at the race track the day prior and drove the aforementioned vehicle. I asked JEANETTE if he had done anything uncharacteristic during his visit to the race track the previous day. He then admitted to leaving the note. He related that he did it as a prank and meant no ill intent.

Based on the lewd, lascivious, threatening and obscene words/language contained on the note that the defendant left in clear plain view of a highly profiled event attended by mostly African American guests, I respectfully request that due process be initiated against the defendant, Peter JEANETTE.
