to eligible seniors in Bucks County

If eligible, you'll receive \$20 per person in vouchers—and a couple can get \$40!*

Vouchers are available at senior centers until September 30, 2018 while supplies last. *Persons unable to attend a senior center may designate a person by calling the Area Agency on Aging at 267-880-5700 for a Proxy Form.*

*SENIORS MUST BE 60 or older by December 31st of the program year and meet the income eligibility guidelines found at www.agriculture.pa.gov as stated at right.

Each eligible recipient receives four (4) \$5 program checks. You must reside in Bucks County.

Seniors who live in facilities where meals are provided are not eligible.

Each eligible recipient receives four (4) \$5 program checks to redeem at a qualified farmers' markets or roadside stands.
