



On May 26, 2010, and thereafter this cover sheet will be required on most civil filings in Pennsylvania's Courts of Common Pleas. Exceptions are noted in the Notice below the form.
- Confidential Information Form
This form is for use in Magisterial District Courts only. While most information in court files is open and available to the public, certain information is nonpublic. If you are required to include Social Security information or personal financial information on court filings, use this form. The information will not be placed in public files.

- Civil Complaint
[Filing Instructions](#) - This is the civil complaint form for use in filing small claims. Tenants also should use this form when filing complaints about landlords. You need to have one copy of the civil complaint with original signature for the magisterial district judge. You will be charged filing costs and service costs when the complaint is filed at the district court. No changes may be made to this form either in content or format.
