INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF FORM

- A. All information shall be typed or printed in black or blue ink.
- B. Associations which conduct bingo during one period each year for not more than 3 consecutive days shall pay a \$15 annual licensing fee. Recognized senior citizens' groups who conduct bingo for their members only shall be a fee of \$50 per year. The license fee for all other nonprofit associations, including agricultural associations and county fairs, is \$100 per year.
- C. The application shall be signed by the executive officer or secretary of the association.
- D. The association must have existed and conducted business in furtherance of its written constitution, charter, articles of incorporation or express purpose for two years prior to applying for a license. Exception: An association whose membership consists exclusively of elderly residents of a senior citizen housing project may apply for a license immediately after it is organized.
